### Playtime

As soon as the war started, even the most basic of raw materials were in great demand and under strict control by the government of the day. Very quickly toyshops ran out of stock; the metal, wood and paper once used to make toys was instead used to support the war effort. Children learned how to make interesting toys out of whatever materials they could find around the home.

Can you research or create a game that the children of WWII could keep themselves entertained with? Think carefully about the resources that the children may have had at their disposal from a small ball, to a rope or wood.
